

It gives us immense pleasure to share the news that Sankalp Trust has been ranked as the #1 Special Needs School in the country by Education World Rankings 2022 - 23. We would like to express our immense gratitude to all our stakeholders without whom this would not have been possible.





RCI APPROVAL FOR TEACHER TRAINING

Sankalp is now an RCI Approved Teacher Training Centre. After a detailed inspection by a team from RCI, Sankalp got its approval for conducting a Diploma in Spl. Ed. (IDD) which is a two year course. With this it gives us hope to build a cadre of well-trained special educators. In August 2023, we will commence training our first batch for Diploma in Special Education (Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities).

HROUGH songs, humorous narratives and theatrical flair, the members of Kathai Kalatta team welcomed the audience at Sankalp - The Learning Centre and Special Needs School to Milan, the autism awareness day celebrations. Even though the storytellers Pretigaya Haran, Ambujavalli Nagarajan, Debjani and Vikram Sridhar — selected different styles to present their stories, the common link was the message — the need for acceptance and inclusion. "This was our first autism awareness event. We were a little worried. But the crowd of school and college kids motivated us to perform and even improvise our stories," agreed the storytellers in unison.

This was the first time Sankalp held a storytelling session with kids from local government schools, private schools, and universities, even though programmes are held during Autism Awareness month, April, every year. "This school is situated in a semi-rural area. Since we have moved away from the city, there is a greater need of creating awareness. To begin with, children should have awareness and stories are the best method to get to them. We invited kids from Sri Chaitanya Techno School, Kolapancherri, and Chennai Public School, Thirumuzhisai and Anna Nagar. The stories were also curated in such a way that every kid understands the core message of the need to be empathetic. We had different sessions with the Kathai Kalatta team. Through presentations, we put forward the areas we wanted to cover and they performed everything well," said Sulata Ajith, founder and director, Sankalp.

Sankalp, started in 1999, is in-

volved in remedial instruction to children with disabilities like Dyslexia (learning disability) and Autism Spectrum Disorder. The staff affirmed that it is currently the best special school in the country according to the ranking of Education World. Dr Mullasari Ajith, cardiologist and managing trustee of Sankalp, shared, "Autism Spectrum Disorder is one of the increasing problems in our country. We currently have two schools with 60 teachers, 10 other staff and 15 helpers assisting almost 250 students in total. Our aim is to include children with disabilities and focus on improving their communication, socialisation and behavioural skills." Addressing the need to give special attention and training to children with disabilities, Kurian Manavalan, trustee of Sankalp, shared, "The studentteacher ratio in special schools is high, here it is 2:1. This makes it expensive to run the school. We need to become a safe environment for the kids. We have been lucky because of our sponsors. Sankalp is also planning to be launched in other cities like Kochi."

The organisation aims to partner with the team of storytellers to conduct story sessions throughout the month. The team is also inviting admissions to their teacher training session. Sulata explained, "Sankalp is starting a Diploma in Special Education programme approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India, with an aim of building a cadre of highly-trained and specialised educators. The course commences in July 2023. Admission for this course is open."

Awareness Programs to sensitize teachers on Specific Learning Disabilities was conducted for Primary school teachers of Excel Global School on 26th November 2022 and for Primary school teachers of Chennai Primary school on 15th of December 2022.

The sessions were to spread awareness on the various manifestations of Learning Disabilities in a classroom and how it affects a child's performance. A part of the programme was also to make the teachers aware on where to get assistance to help the child.

Checklists were handed out to the teachers to help them identify children who could be at risk and need to be tested. Feedback from the teachers is awaited.

CERTIFICATE COURSE ON REMEDIAL TEACHING




MOU SIGNED WITH HINDUSTAN COLLEGE

The students will attend 30 hours of Theory and Practical classes followed by 20 hours of Internship at The Open School.









THE COMMITTEE (CONSTITUTED BY THE STATE COMMISSIONER FOR PWD)

Lakshmi Krishna Kumar and Sangeetha Karthike are a part of the Committee constituted by the State Commissioner for Persons With Disabilities. This Committee is made up of experts in the field and have put forth the collective difficulties faced by persons with disabilities (Dyslexia).



They have made recommendations for policy framework and guidelines specifically for persons with Dyslexia the State must adopt while making interventions for persons with disabilities including students.

The committee formed conducted series of meetings and framed this Policy, Guidelines, Standard Operating Procedures, and Budget estimate for Specific Learning Disabilities in Tamil Nadu, which will enhance early detection and providing appropriate interventions for persons with Specific Learning Disabilities.

24TH-25TH MARCH, 2023 - PAPER PRESENTATION AT RAJIV GANDHI UNIVERSITY,

Ms. Lakshmi Krishnakumar- Director, Learning Disabilities, presented a Research Paper entitled "Youth Entrepreneurship and Employability Skills for Students With Specific Learning Disabilities" at the Two-Day National Conference on Youth Development with the theme Youth in the 21st Century: Prospects and Psychosocial Challenges.

The conference was jointly organized by the Department of Social Work & Department of Applied Psychology, RGNIYD in collaboration with ICMR – NIRT, Chennai on 24-25 March 2023. The conference was sponsored by the ICSSR, New Delhi.

This paper was based on a Study conducted by Sankalp - The Open School to understand the readiness of children for Vocational Training. For this purpose, a survey was conducted among parents/educators having/handling youth in the age group 15-18 years, using an online questionnaire and implemented through Google forms.

The paper presentation was well received and appreciated by the organizers of the event.





April

"PRAYAAS"- THE VOCATIONAL SKILLS UNIT: GRADUATION OF THE FIRST BATCH

Prayaas caters exclusively to the needs of children with Specific Learning Disabilities. The main aim is to train students above 16 years with working skills that are required to make them employable and independent.

The first batch of students were given training in a wide array of skills like Data Entry, Desk Top Publishing, Book Binding, Weaving, Culinary Art, Retail, Jewelry Design, Paper Bag making and Impression Art. They also did an internship with Suder Bakery and were involved in baking, over the counter sales and the packing process.

Prayaas also imparted soft skills that are so important in a working environment like Communication Skills, Executive Functioning Skills and Logical and Reasoning Skills.

The inhouse meal planning and prepping training led to the soft launch of in house "Prayaas Kitchen". The students prepared and served a wholesome menu that was preordered by the teachers. The students took the orders, collected the payment and issued tokens. The first batch of students graduated In April 2023 after a period of two years.

The students prepared a sumptuous lunch on the final day and served their parents.













17th to 21st April, 2023 - FIE Training-Basic Level 1

The teachers underwent a 5 day training programme in Feuerstein Instrumental Enrichment (FIE) conducted by Ms. Jayashree Ashok. Instrumental Enrichment is a process-oriented cognitive intervention program. Consisting of 14 specially designed instruments or 'tools,' FIE is a series of pencil-and-paper tasks that may be mediated in a classroom, group or individual setting. Each series focuses on different cognitive skills, creating systematic, persistent and structured conditions to engage students in problem solving by developing their ability to understand and elaborate information. 19 in-house teachers and 4 educators from outside attended the program. It is proposed to include Instrumental Enrichment as a part of the curriculum from next academic year to enhance cognitive skills for academic learning achievement.







AFTER SCHOOL REMEDIATION PROGRAMMES: JANUARY TO APRIL 2023
